World Day for Safety & Health at Work

IFAP encourages organisations to get involved in World Day for Safety and Health at Work this month.

World Day for Safety and Health at Work is an international campaign to promote safe, healthy, and decent work held on April 28.

Since 2003, the International Labour Organization (ILO) began to observe World Day, supported by the International Social Security Association (ISSA).

The objective of the day is to focus international attention on the magnitude of the problem and how promoting and creating a safety and health culture can help reduce the number of work-related deaths each year.

Mines Rescue Competition Commemorated Varaschetti Rescue

IFAP Kalgoorlie were a proud sponsor of the annual CME Surface Mine Emergency Response Competition, held on March 23-25 in Coolgardie.

The competition is the largest held in the Southern Hemisphere. Sixteen teams were tasked with realistic scenarios including fire fighting, first aid, vehicle extrication, hazardous chemicals, rope rescue, and confined space rescue.

The competition coincided with celebrations of the Centenary of the Varaschetti Mine Rescue. On March 28 1907, mine rescuers freed Modesto Varaschetti who had been trapped for nine days underground at the Bonnievale gold mine.

IFAP Wins Gold WorkSafe Plan Award

IFAP has been awarded a Gold "WorkSafe Plan" Certificate of Achievement for its Occupational Safety and Health Management Plan. This will be presented by the WorkSafe WA Commissioner in April to coincide with **World Day for Safety and Health at Work (April 28)**.

"WorkSafe Plan" promotes the management practices needed to establish and maintain safe working environments. A Gold Certificate acknowledges the organisation is demonstrating the commitment and management practices that occupational safety and health laws promote.

Organisations are also required to show that their work-related rates of injury and disease are reducing or kept at low levels. WorkSafe Plan has five elements with each having a standard to achieve: Management Commitment; Planning; Consultation; Hazard Management; and Training. The certificate is valid for three years.
