## Bridging Course Approved by OPITO

IFAP Fremantle - Management of Major Hazards, is now approved to deliver the OPITO bridging course.

This programme is designed to bridge the training requirements between those previously completed during an OPITO Tropical BOSIET (Basic Offshore Safety Induction & Emergency Training) course and those required for the OPITO BOSIET course.

Participants should be aware that upon completion of this course they will receive an OPITO BOSIET certification, however their course will still be dated from when they completed their last full TBOSIET/TFOET (Tropical Further Offshore Emergency Training) course. This is in place to ensure that all other competencies completed during the TBOSIET course are still refreshed as required when due.

An alternative for bridging from the TBOSIET to the BOSIET is to complete a FOET - the BOSIET refresher course. By completing the FOET course the delegates new card/certificate will be dated from when the FOET course was completed. This is possible because all the original TBOSIET competencies covered are refreshed during the FOET course plus the additional competencies required to achieve a BOSIET certification are also covered.
