Common Safety Training Program

Did you know it is a recommended industry requirement that all new entrants into the offshore oil and gas industry complete the **Common Safety Training Program (CSTP)**?

Established as an initiative by **APPEA**, the CSTP course offered by IFAP comprises of a 3 day hands-on training course followed by a period of workplace behaviour demonstration. The program is focused on the demonstration of safety behaviours identified by offshore oil and gas industry leaders as being essential and includes content such as the Safety Case, working under an issued permit, working safely, controlling minor incidents and responding to an emergency.
