Train Your Staff for Under \$75

If you employ less than 20 people, then the Small Business Smart Business Training Voucher program is for you.

Designed to assist small businesses to invest in training and develop their management skills and knowledge, the Small Business Smart Business (SBSB) Program provides training vouchers of up to \$200 to businesses with fewer than 20 employees.

An initiative of the **Department of Education and Training**, this scheme is valid for training undertaken in a range of approved training courses **before 31 March 2006**. IFAP has two courses which have been approved by the Department of Education and Training for inclusion in the SBSB Program.

Both courses are designed to increase awareness of safety issues in the workplace and provide skills to manage a safe system of work as required under the OSH legislation. Details of these courses, including the training discount, are as follows:

OSH Management Fundamentals - 1 day**Next course: March 29**

Course Fees:

IFAP Members - \$74.50 (Normal fee of \$249 less training discount of \$174.50)

Non-members - \$525 (Normal fee of \$725 less training discount of \$200)
