New Competence Unit for the Offshore Industry

Representatives from IFAP have played a key role in the development of a new national competence for crane operators in the offshore industry.

A sub-committee consisting of high level industry representatives from BHP Billiton, CIMA Pty Ltd, IFAP, IMES, ENI, Woodside, APPEA and NOPSA was formed last year to develop a useful and comprehensive offshore lifting competence unit.

IFAP's AQTF Coordinator, Charis Neumann, provided substantial input with her role on the steering committee which included advice on the structure, format and content of the competencies to meet Training Package requirements.

Completed in December 2007, the Unit of Competence for Operating Offshore Cranes is now formally part of the new PMA08 National Training Package which will replace PMA02. It is now expected that this package will be endorsed by the National Quality Council of the Department of Education, Science and Training by March this year.

Members of the steering committee have emphasised that industry should understand the new Unit will not replace existing State or Territory licensing requirements which will continue to apply. Instead it is designed to provide competent performance benchmarks for offshore crane operators with a ticket. For more information, please contact **NOPSA** on **08 9338 4812**
