Originally founded 1962 as the Industrial Division of the National Safety Council of WA, IFAP became independent of the NSCA 10 years later taking on its present name.

Key milestones include:
 1987 Construction of training and admin centre at North Lake
 1990 Skills Training Centre added.
 1998 Fire Training Centre opened and partnership with Red Alert commenced.
 1994 Survival Training Centre constructed in North Fremantle.
 2004 Centre for Crisis and Emergency Management opened.
 2005 IFAP Kalgoorlie – Goldfields Safety Centre opened.
 2006 First interstate centre opened; IFAP Darwin – North Australian Safety Centre.
 2007 IFAP Bibra Lake opens and commences delivery of induction training, a joint initiative with Induction Centres Australia.

To commemorate its 35 year milestone, IFAP is holding a **Gala Anniversary Ball on November 8.**

Special guest speaker for the evening is **Professor Martin Flynn Ph.D.** addressing the topic **“Men are from Mars, Women are from Venus – Implications for workplace safety”.**
