Emergency Responders: AIIMS

The recent co-ordinated response to an oil spill off the Western Australian Coastline has seen the integration of industry and government in managing the emergency and crisis.

The Australian Maritime Authority (AMSA) and West Australian State Government implemented their marine pollution plans along with industry to ensure that the spill was responded to as effectively and efficiently as possible.

The founding arrangements of this response is the adoption of the **Australasian Inter-Service Incident Management System (AIIMS)** now used by AMSA and the West Australian Government. This system has been implemented by the fire and emergency services for almost 2 decades and is now being adopted by police services. The key to effective co-ordinated response has been the simple knowledge and adoption of this system by industry.




For the last year, IFAP has been conducting AIIMS training for industry under licence from the Australasian Fire and Emergency Services Council. Many organisations are now adopting AIIMS as the founding emergency response structure within their organisations, or if not, being orientated to the structure to ensure that they can integrate with emergency services during major accident events.
