With recent high-profile incidents and changes in safety legislation, what does the future hold for the offshore industry?

Offshore Petroleum Safety: Priorities for NOPSA 2010 and Beyond

Analysis of incidents and dangerous occurrences in the Australian offshore petroleum industry over the last five years has consistently highlighted the need to ensure that equipment is properly maintained, procedures are followed and the basic design is safe.

Recent high profile incidents have further emphasised that a safe industry is the culmination of diligent effort by operators responsible for the safety of their facilities, together with challenge and oversight by an independent regulator.

The role of National Offshore Petroleum Safety Authority (NOPSA) is to administer offshore petroleum safety legislation. The organisation's primary objectives include:

- Improving health and safety outcomes across the offshore petroleum industry
- Ensuring health and safety regulation of the offshore petroleum industry is provided to standards that are equal to the best in the world
- Reducing the regulatory burden on the offshore petroleum industry, which operates across multiple jurisdictions, by delivering a consistent and comprehensive health and safety regime
